Eligibility

- All contestants must attend a school located in Higginsville, Mo.
- Contestants will compete in modeling both casual wear and formal wear.
- An entry fee of \$15 per contestant must be submitted with a completed entry form no later than September 1, 2019.
- Contestants may obtain a sponsor, however this is not required. The emcee will announce all sponsors during the casual wear competition.
- If a winner from the previous year is moving up in age division they are eligible to participate.

Agenda

1:00 p.m.	The stage will be available for practice, dressing rooms open. Doors will remain locked until 1:00 p.m. The stage will be closed at 2:40 p.m. as guests will begin arriving.
2:15 p.m.	All contestants should be present and dressed in casual wear . Please allow time to check in upon arrival. There will be a brief informational meeting for parents and participants at this time.
3:00 p.m.	Pageant begins.

Casual wear

All contestants compete in this category. Casual wear can be anything worn to a casual affair. It can be long pants, shorts, a skirt or even a casual dress. <u>All contestants should arrive dressed in casual wear.</u>

Formal wear

All ages compete in this category. Formal wear should be a dress (any length) that could be worn for a special occasion. During this competition, contestants will walk to the microphone and say <u>only</u> their **name**, **age** and **favorite thing to do**.

Modeling Pattern

The description below explains the modeling pattern that should be followed during the pageant.

- Each contestant will first walk on stage and proceed to position 1.
- Contestants will then continue to position 2 and will complete a full turn (they show the audience their back with a brief pause, then turn and show their face again.) This will also be the position where the contestant will state their name, age and favorite thing to do during the formalwear competition.
- Contestant then continues to position 3 where they pause for a few seconds, then turns left and walks off the stage.
- Each age division will be brought back on stage for a final look after all contestants have been introduced. At this time, the emcee will call each contestant's name and the contestant should step forward for a brief pause before stepping back into line.

Awards

Contestants will be judged on overall appearance, personality, stage presence, and self-confidence. Each judge will give each contestant a score of up to 10 points in each category of competition. The contestant with the highest score in her age division will be crowned princess. Runners-up will receive a sash. All contestants will receive participation medallions and goody bags.

Parade

The Princess and Runners-up in each age division will ride in the Country Fair Parade on Saturday, September 21, 2019. Information on parade times and locations will be announced at the pageant.

Back Stage Area

Only one assisting female chaperone may move between the dressing room and auditorium so that disruptions are kept to a minimum. During competition, the chaperone should meet their contestant in the dressing area only after the entire group for that age division has completed the casual wear competition. All participants are to remain in the designated areas. **Contestant bullying will not be allowed**, Pi Nu reserves the right to report such actions to the judges and points will be deducted from the participant who has bullied. *Parents/chaperones are not allowed in the line-up area.* Thank you for your cooperation.
